



TIPS FOR RACE FANS

2008 Greenville Hospital System USA Cycling Professional Championships - Individual Time Trial - Saturday, August 30

This is the third year the best professional cyclists in the country have competed in a championship for the Individual Time Trial discipline, known as the "race of truth". Admission for spectators is free for this event and cameras are permitted all along the route.

- 🚲 Start/Finish will feature a new course at the Clemson University International Center for Automotive Research (CU-ICAR)
- 🚲 Race starts at 11:00 a.m. and expected to finish at 1:10 p.m.
- 🚲 The Championship course is 6.9 miles in length, with three laps for a total of 20.7 miles
- 🚲 Staggered start at two minute intervals for all competitors
- 🚲 Close to 40 professional athletes expected in the field, including two-time defending champion David Zabriskie of Salt Lake City, UT who races for Garmin/Chipotle presented by H30
- 🚲 FREE for all spectators
- 🚲 Listen to race announcers call the action at the start/finish line

Location:

The Greenville CU-ICAR campus is located off of Millennium Blvd. in Technology Neighborhood I. Parking for all buildings in Neighborhood I is provided in one parking deck, called AutoPark. The AutoPark and the attached CU-ICAR Partnership Office building address is: 5 Research Drive, Greenville, SC 29607

Directions From Interstate 85:

Take Exit 48 East toward Mauldin, SC (Highway 276 East, Laurens Road). At the next traffic light, turn left on Millennium Blvd, which is the main thoroughfare entering the CU-ICAR campus. Drive into the campus approx. 1 mile and turn left on Research Drive. Approx 2 miles from I-85 intersect with Laurens Road.
