



STARS AND STRIPES CHALLENGE *** AUGUST 30-31, 2008

5K and One Mile Fun Run/Walk

- 🚲 Begins at 8:00 a.m. on Saturday morning of the USA Cycling Professional Individual Time Trial Championships
- 🚲 Course located at Clemson University – International Center for Automotive Research in Greenville. The Greenville CU-ICAR campus is located off of Millennium Blvd. in Technology Neighborhood I, 12 miles from downtown Greenville.
- 🚲 Cross the finish line that the professional riders will cross as they complete the time trial later that day
- 🚲 Afterwards, participants can watch the best pro cyclists in the United States compete for the Stars and Stripes Time Trial Jersey.
- 🚲 Net proceeds benefit the Greenville Hospital System Oncology Research Institute and Activate Upstate, a free, year-round healthy living program led by the YMCA of Greenville, Greenville Hospital System and Furman University.
- 🚲 One entry fee – includes T-shirt
 - \$15 – Adults
 - \$10 – Children (12 & Under)
 - \$20/\$15 after August 15

Bicycle Ride

- 🚲 Begins at 7:30 a.m. to Noon on Sunday immediately before the USA Cycling Professional Road Race Championship.
- 🚲 Unique fundraising concept provides incentives for participants based on fundraising efforts.
 - Standard entry fee is \$50 per rider. The more funds you raise, the more prizes you receive
 - An optional Family Fun Ride, sponsored by BI-LO, will begin at 10 a.m. in Cleveland Park. It is FREE for the entire family. One adult is required to ride with each family.
- 🚲 Allows participants the opportunity to ride the same road race course as the pro cyclists, with an option to climb Paris Mountain
- 🚲 Ride the 22-mile Road Race circuit as many times as you want until Noon.
- 🚲 The Stars and Stripes Challenge is a recreational Ride – Not a race. Helmets are required.
- 🚲 Proceeds benefit The Lance Armstrong Foundation and Greenville Hospital System Oncology Research Institute
